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5. A) Note to Teacher: See note at the top of the first page.

What was sent to the villagers in South America to help them get clean water?

Suggested answer: empty water tanks

B) Draw a picture of the villagers drinking water *after* other people heard about their dirty water problem.

Suggested answer: Students' pictures should include large water tanks and happy villagers drinking *clean* water.

What did you learn from "A Clean Drink of Water"?

Suggested answer: Answers may vary and should be supported by the passage.

7. Note to Teacher: See note at the top of the first page.

Class Discussion Question: Were the empty water tanks a helpful solution to the problem the people in the village had? Explain your answer using evidence from the text.

Suggested answer: Answers may vary yet students should indicate that the empty water tanks were a helpful solution. The problem was that the people in the village did not have access to clean drinking water that did not make them sink. The empty water tanks were a helpful solution because clean rainwater fell into the tanks, allowing the people to use the clean water.
